

Utica Roadrunners Code of Conduct

At all times, Members of the Utica Roadrunners (Club) shall behave in accordance with the Club Code of Conduct, while participating in Club workouts, races, activities, volunteer positions and all other social and public events.

Members shall:

- Conduct themselves in a manner that will ensure a welcoming and comfortable environment
- Always show respect for one another and opponents
- Never make unwanted verbal, sexual or physical contact with others
- Refrain from using negative or derogatory language in competitive or social environments or when corresponding via written or Internet communications
- Respect the age, religion, ethnic background, gender and sexual orientation of other members and opponents
- Behave in a manner that is safe and never put themselves or others at risk

Members are responsible to ensure that this Code of Conduct is followed and are expected to report any inappropriate actions or behaviors, in writing, to a Club officer.

Membership may be terminated by resignation of a member, or by a 2/3 vote of the Club Board of Directors, for violations of this Code of Conduct without full or partial reimbursement of membership dues.
